BACKGROUND

- Since 2000 doctors had been capacited regularly in medical databases for reference librarians.
- During 2002 User's
 Instruction was
 programme and
 scheduled in the New
 Resident Induction
 Programs.

 Biomedical Library and the Faculty of Medicine did a workshop for a group of 80 New Medical Residents to teach them databases and information retrieval in Evidence Based Medicine.

AIMS

At the end of the workshop the residents would be able to:

- Develop skills in the use of Evidence Based Medicine databases (Cochrane Library, Pubmed, Clinical Queries, Tripdatabase)
- Use of Mesh Database in their search strategies.
- Use filters to limit searching's results

METHODS

- Teachers : Medical Reference Librarians
- Four 3.45 hour sessions
- 20 residents / session with his own computer
- Introductory databases power point presentation
- Individual task with a database's guide and a work's guide

The assistence was calendarized and obligatory


