# Trial

- Randomized controlled trial of EBHC
- Randomize health care professionals to receive training in EBHC
- Does it affect patient outcome
- Send for ethical approval

# Curriculum

- Why
  - There are many people ‘teaching EB’
  - There are many people ‘practicing EB’
  - EB is used by managers and politicians to change practice without all steps.

- Definition
- 5 (6) steps
- Pedagogically sound
- Sent serially round a steering committee
- Sent to all Sicily attendees
- Sent to BMJ
