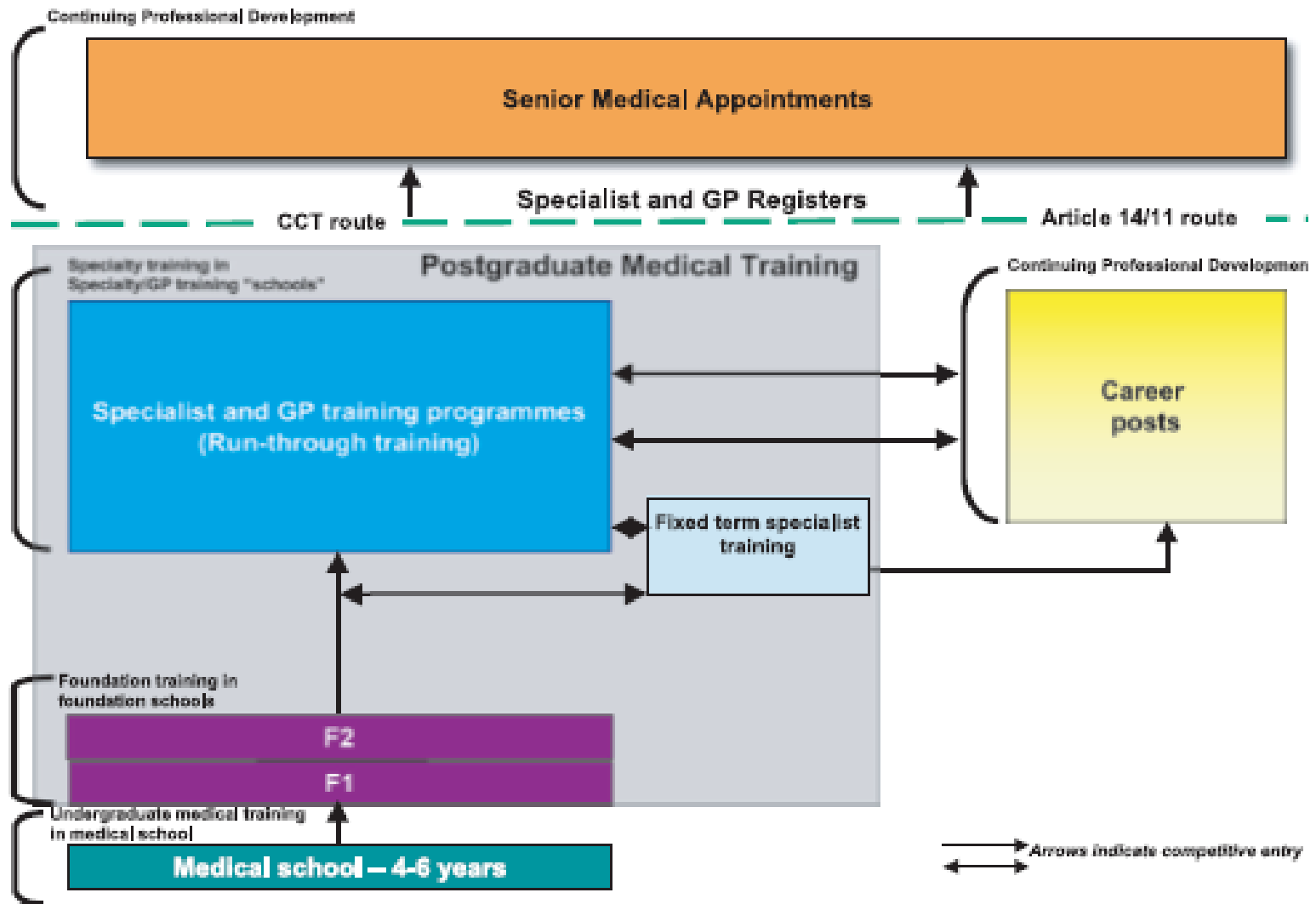

 - Contextual; person, family, community, culture
 - Attitudinal; professional capabilities
 - Scientific; critical, research based approach to Practice and CPD
