1. Background

- There is an impressive number of web sites and search engines about EBP, EBHC, Clinical Governance, but most of them:
 - collect links to other resources and/or
 - did not provide systematically reviews on published literature
 - have variable quality
 - does not describe the methods for searching, appraising and selecting resources

1. Background

 The methodological literature about "Evidence-based Knowledge" is growing.

• The MeSH thesaurus is unsatisfactory to index this literature: both sensitivity and specificity are low

 A dedicated database is lacking and we would like...





- More than 300.000 code-lines


Software Architecture





- It is very difficult to score the "quality" of the methodological articles and the other resources:
 - time restraint
 - several "narrative articles"
 - lack of tools for scoring most of records
- EBHC Library does not capture relevant articles not archived in MEDLINE → need to find and manually input them








