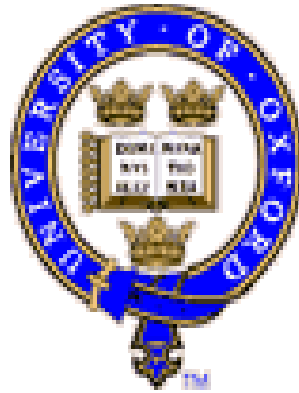

Oxford International Programme in EBHC

- Series of modules
- Students can take modules as standalone short courses
- Modules can be combined together to obtain:
 - **Certificate** (3 modules) Health Research
 - **Diploma** (6 modules) Health Research
 - **MSc** (6 modules plus research project) EBHC
- Flexible:
 - 1 to 6 modules per year
 - 1 to 6 years to complete MSc
- Part-time **DPhil** (PhD) in EBHC over 6 years

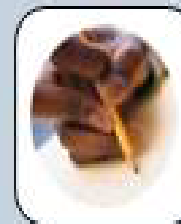
