2. Some explanations

About aims

- The aim is the management of “**methodological literature and other resources EBHC-related**”
- EBHC Library moves toward an “**organized social network**”:
 - open access, with registration
 - indexed with EBHC thesaurus
 - involving users for
 - ratings and comments
 - new technical features

2. Some explanations

About users' interactions

- EBHC Thesaurus is restricted, but open to EBHC WG suggestions
- For every resource, users can suggest new keywords from Thesaurus, but cannot use free text for tagging (risking to back from order to chaos)
- No training is required for rating articles

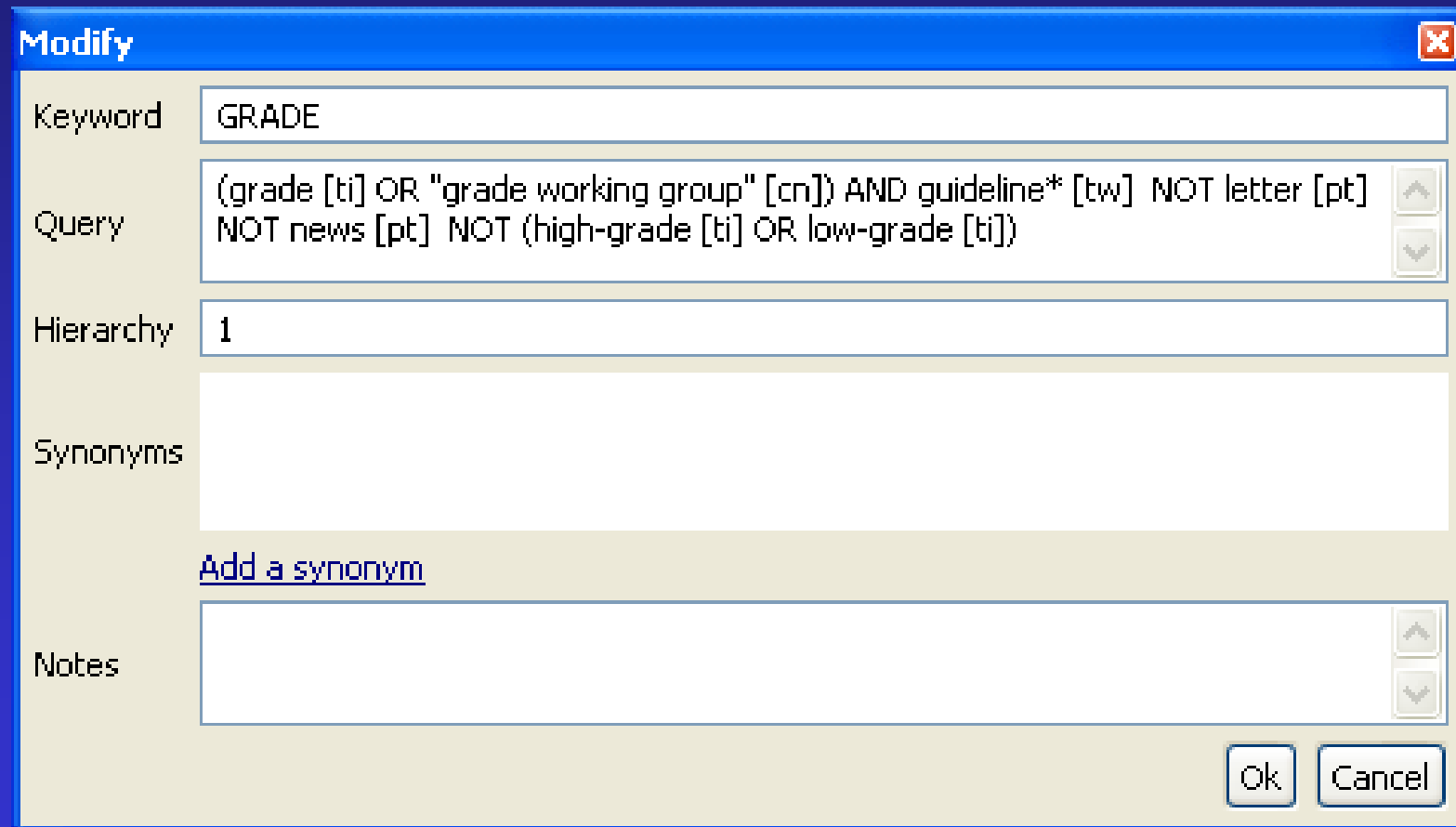
2. Some explanations

About differences: MEDLINE, Google

- Thesaurus
 - Google: no thesaurus
 - MEDLINE
 - methodological MeSH terms are < 500
 - EBHC Thesaurus > 3.000 terms
- Content
 - MEDLINE contains only articles
 - Google is a generic search engine: low specificity of results

2. Some explanations

About differences: MEDLINE, Google

2. Some explanations

About contents

- EBHC Library collects **only methodological resources** and not clinical evidence as: Cochrane Library, TRIP database, PubMed Clinical Queries, McMaster MORE project, Dynamed, NPC
- No systematic searches and critical appraisal to include the resources into the Library
- 3 education journals are included in the “Core Methodological Journals”: Acad Med, BMC Med Educ, Med Educ.

3. Accepted suggestions

- To open an “EBHC Library account” on Twitter, Delicious and other social bookmarking tools
- Review the Journals Lists using (more than EBHC Library WG suggestions):
 - Journal Citation Index
 - SciMago
- To explore Erasmus funding
- Involvement of EBP/EBHC Masters’ students
- Limit for publication date (already available)
- RSS feeds (already planned)

- Opening “EBHC Library accounts” on the web 2.0
- EBHC Thesaurus
 - Review, expand tree, debug
 - Developing new search strategies
- Limiting the contents to “core clinical journals”
- Providing
 - Resources suggestion form → increase of resource number
 - Rating, comments and interaction tools
